













MOTOSTUDENT REGISTRATION PROCESS

This document has been created to help all the MotoStudent teams and their team leaders/team members/team tutors to register the team and all its members for the MotoStudent International Competition!

To help you, the document explains the three different registrations your team has to proceed depending on the role each person has in the team: Team Registration, Team Leader Registration and Team members/Team Tutors Registration.

TEAM REGISTRATION

Registration opened on **1st March 2024**, and the deadline for registration is **30 days before the Final Event**. Please note that the places are limited and teams have different Milestones to deliver.

The Team Registration process is explained below:

• Each team has to register their Team through the MotoStudent Platform, where you will find the option "Register your team".






Once the team clicks on the above button a new window will open and there you will find all the team information to fill in.

- Once the Team Registration has been submitted, the Administration Department will validate the data, prepare the proforma invoice and send it to the Team Leader and Team Tutor contact indicated in the Registration Form. The Team will be accepted as an official MotoStudent Team once the proforma invoice has been paid.
- Once the Administration Department confirms the payment with the bank details, the team will be contacted by email, sending to the team leader and tutor the **WELCOME TO MOTOSTUDENT email**.






TEAM LEADER/TEAM MEMBERS/TEAM TUTORS REGISTRATION

The first member who must be officially registered in the team is the Team Leader. This step is very important, as the Team Leader is the person in charge of accepting the rest of Team Members/Team Tutors in the team.

Once the Team Leader is registered, team members/team tutors can start registering through the MotoStudent Platform.

To apply for the registration, team leader/team member/team tutor must go to the MotoStudent platform and click on "Register a Member":




• You must fill the following registration form. Here, we explain some of the fields that may generate doubts:

- Add a personal photo.
- **Team:** select your Team Name from the list.
- Rol: select your Team Rol.
- Complete your **personal data**, information about your **studies** and your **LinkedIn Profile**.
- Upload your CV: uploading your CV will help you to attract the top automotive companies in order to find your dreams job.
- Upload your **University Registration**: here, you have to upload an official document that justifies your relation with your University:
- **Team Leader/Team Member:** Official university enrolment document for the period 2023-2024 or 2024-2025.
- **Team Tutor:** University contract or official certificate from the University justifying the employment contract with the University.
- Accept the terms and conditions of the platform.
- Agreement and compliance with the Rules and Official Competition Documents.
- Accept the terms and conditions of the job board.








Save the information and wait for the Organisation to validate the user. Once the validation process is finished, the team leader/team member/team tutor will receive an email confirming the official registration as a team leader.


There is **difference** in the **acceptation** of registration of the Team Leader, from the Team Members/Team tutors.

- 1. Team Leader only has an Administration acceptance:
- MotoStudent confirms the reception of the Team Leader data and start to revise it

MotoStudent confirms the Team Leader registrarion after reviewing all the data Picture 7: Email confirming that the team leader's user has been validated.











- 2. Team Members/Team Tutors have a double acceptance to be registered in the team:
 - In the first instance, verification by the Administration Department.
 - Secondly and finally the the **acceptance** of the **Team Leader** in the Team.
- Once MotoStudent validate Team Member/Team Tutor data, the following email is sent:

Course→My Team and accept the team member/team tutor who is requesting to be registered.






Picture 10: My team Space (depending on the team Electric or Petrol)
